Criterios de selección

- Proceder de uno de los 50 países de la Convención.
- Profesionales de la educación en el sector indicado en cada actividad.
- Conocimiento activo de la lengua de trabajo.
- El taller debe ser relevante para el trabajo del solicitante.
- Los participantes deben contribuir al taller con su experiencia en el ámbito específico.
- Se tendrá en cuenta el potencial multiplicador de los participantes.
- Debe haber un reparto equitativo entre regiones, perfiles, etc.
- Solo se puede participar en un taller o escuela de verano cada dos años.

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ELEGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Beneficiaries have to be education professionals at primary and secondary level (teachers, head teachers, inspectors, pedagogical advisers, child psychologists, school staff, textbook authors, teacher trainers, etc.). They must be nationals of a signatory State to the European cultural Convention and must commit themselves to play an active role as multipliers after the European Workshop;
- The European Workshop must be relevant to the candidate's work;
- The candidate must have an active knowledge of the working language of the European Workshop;
- Candidate's experience in the field covered by the European Workshop: attendance is not enough - candidates must also contribute their knowledge and experience to the discussion. Pre-selection should therefore give preference to those who have already taken part in national discussions or in school projects dealing with the theme of the European Workshop;
- The candidate's potential as a multiplier: this criterion will obviously favor teacher trainers, curriculum-planners, authors of textbooks and other classroom aids, subject coordinators, head teachers, inspectors and other administrators.

The balance between pre-selected candidates must take equitably into consideration the regions, types of schools, themes, etc.


Candidates who participated in a European Workshop in the context of the Pestalozzi Programme within the last 2 years: no candidate is allowed to participate in more than one European Workshop in a two-year period (from date to date).

Summary

Education systems throughout the world are looking for ways of organising learning that go beyond existing institutional arrangements. The schools of XXI century have to equip the young generation with knowledge, skills and functional literacy to participate in today's economy and society. Education that can be used for life, learning that continues over the years are a better use of the teacher's time and the community's funds because pupils can think about what they learn, apply it in real life or future learning, and can continue to learn independently. That is why one of the essential goals of the workshop is the promotion of active learning strategies that help teachers work together to improve pupils' learning and transform their schools into learning communities.

Participants will be able:

- to study the pedagogical approaches, methods and strategies of formation of meta subject competencies of pupils that will help them to become active learners throughout their life, to have research, problem solving and critical thinking skills, to learn together with others, be able to set learning goals and to evaluate their results
- to understand various ways of the development of higher-order "21st century competences" such as making learning and engagement central, ensuring that learning is social and collaborative, being highly attuned to learners' motivations and emotions, being sensitive to individual differences, holding high standards and expectations while keeping a manageable workload, using assessments consistent with learning aims, promoting horizontal connectedness across activities and subjects, in and out of school
- to discuss experience and good practice of European countries that participate in PISA, which not only looks at student performance but also finds out about students' potential for lifelong learning by asking them about their motivation, their self-beliefs and their learning strategies

The module series on intercultural education started in 2006. It was the second series of the new trainer training scheme of the Pestalozzi Programme and was planned to last until spring/summer 2007. The first module (Module A) took place in Strasbourg at the European Youth Centre of the Council of Europe and the second module (Module B) in Oslo, Norway, with the support of the Norwegian Ministry of Education. The five phases of the module series were coordinated by a team of facilitators – Ms Nuria Bernaus, Germany, Ms Pavlina Hadjitheodoulou Loizidou, Cyprus, Mr Hans-Peter Schmidtke, Germany - led by Mr Miguel Essomba, Spain. The coordination of the methodological approach was carried out by Mr Chris Gittins, UK, and Ms Pascale Mompoin-Gaillard in close collaboration with the Secretariat. The training units, edited by Ms Pascale Mompoin-Gaillard, are now available for interested teachers and teacher trainers to try them out, to adapt them and further develop them. The Pestalozzi Programme would appreciate feedback on the available resources, including further resources developed on the basis of the model in its online collection.
