Internationalise the institution

- Implement the *Canary Strategy for the Internationalisation of Education (ECIE)* as a change in the educational system oriented to bilingualism
- It is intended to provide students with tools to improve training and **employability** in a globalised world

- Introduce the concept of ***“internationalisation at home”*** implying a change in the school curriculum to prepare students for performing professionally/socially in an international and multicultural context



- Add an **English version** to the school web www.losgladiolos.es and keep it updated





- Make a stable **infrastructure** to:
 - Mentorise incoming students in Erasmus+ mobilitites
 - Reception of visits by European partners

- Develop on-line material for **bilingual training** in curricular areas
- Include the **international perspective** to share classroom activities with counterpart VET schools through virtual web 2.0 tools opening a specific facility *“Europe Space”* at school

- Establish **bilingual training offer** for incoming students in at least one area of the current school studies

Internationalise the people

- Launch plans to provide **language support** for school teaching staff to:
 - Enable them for bilingual training
 - Receive international visits in cooperation programs/activities participated by CIFP Los Gladiolos

- Launch plans to provide **linguistic/cultural support** for school outgoing students for Erasmus+ mobilities
- Set up support activities for clerical and caretaking staff (phone attention and visit reception)

Foster partnership and alliances



- Achieve **international agreements** to facilitate students' employability
- Encourage **cross-border alliances** and projects (Strategic Partnerships, Mobility Consortia)
- Create **cooperation networks** with counterpart VET schools to share educational expertise
- Promote **reciprocal recruitment** of international staff and dispatching of school staff for teaching activities through *Erasmus Pro*

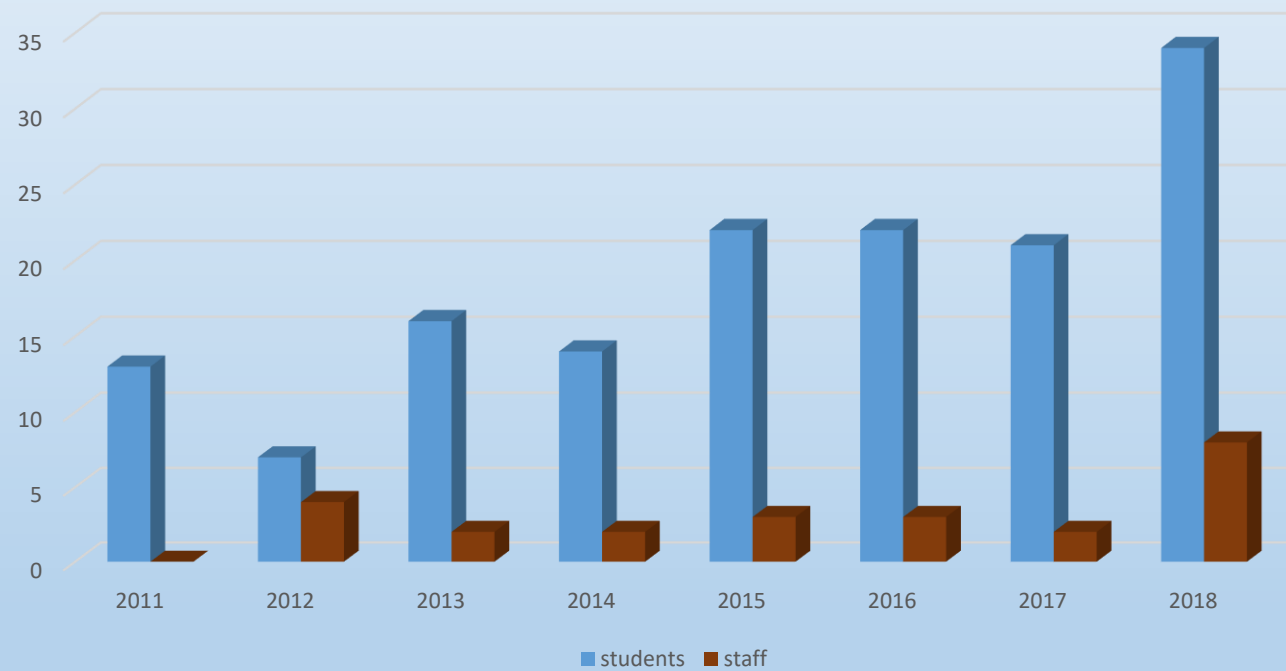

Mobilities (total)

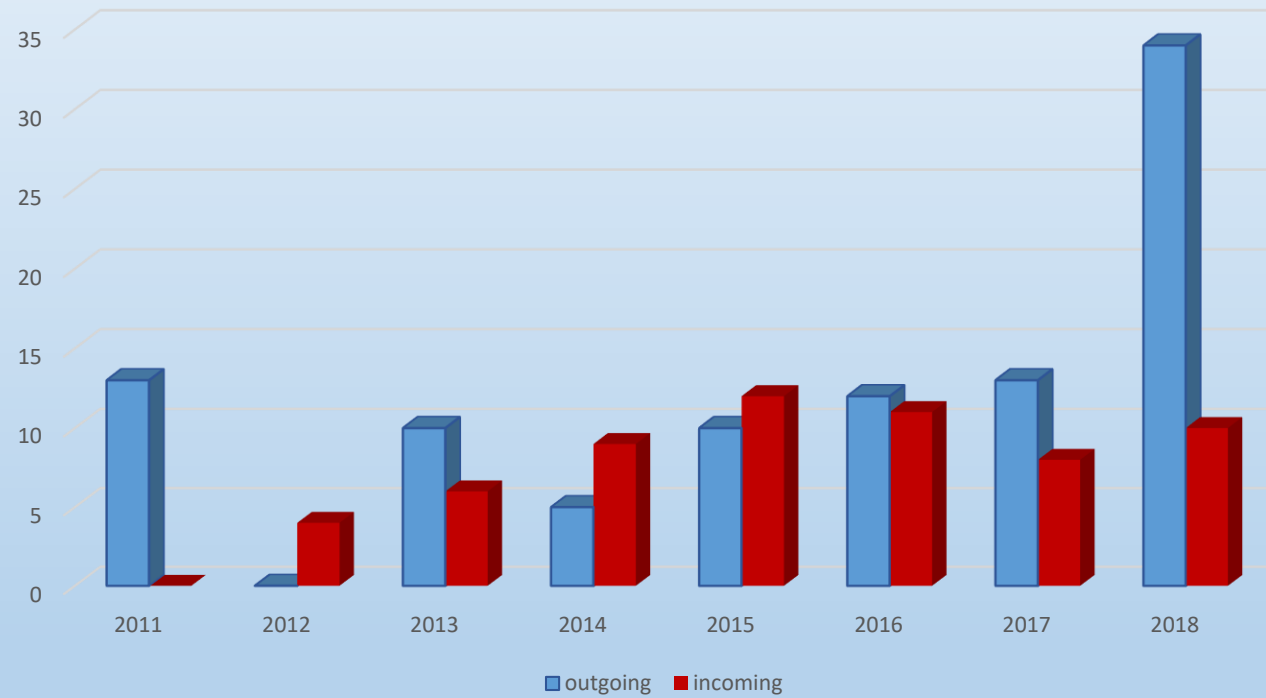


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Mobilities (students)

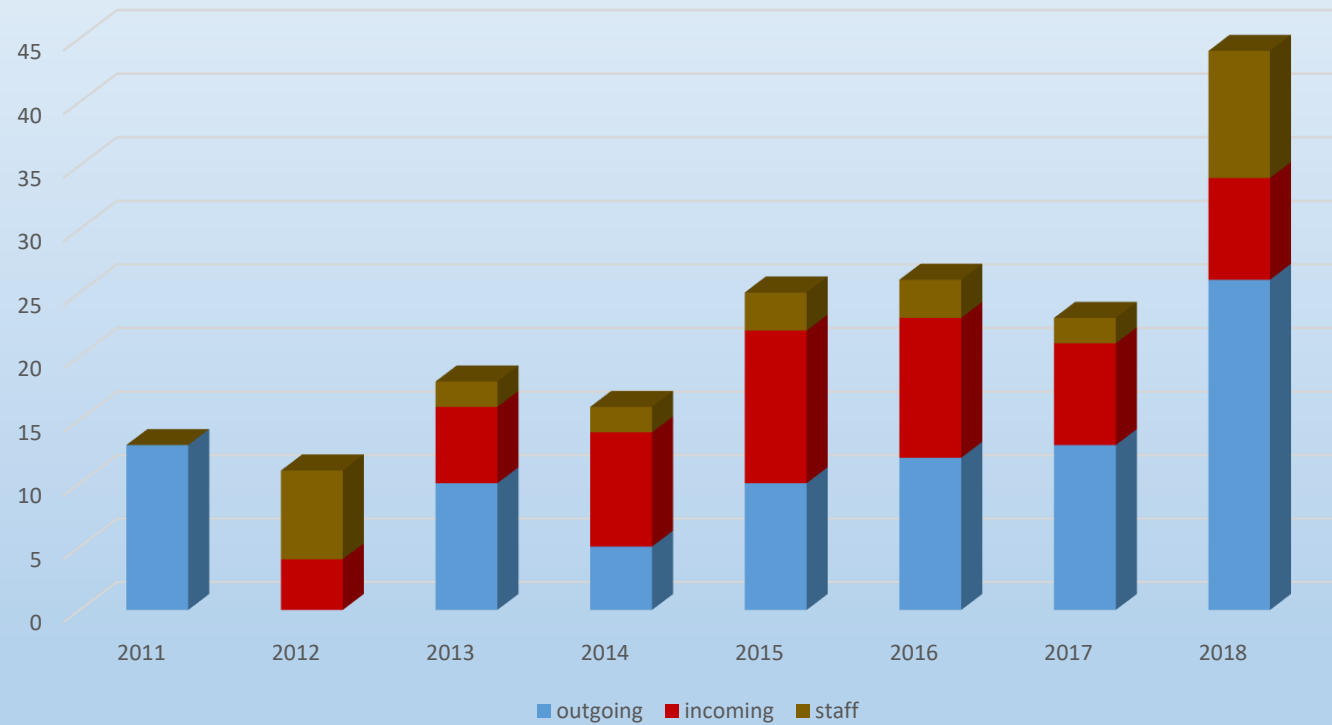


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Mobilities (detailed)

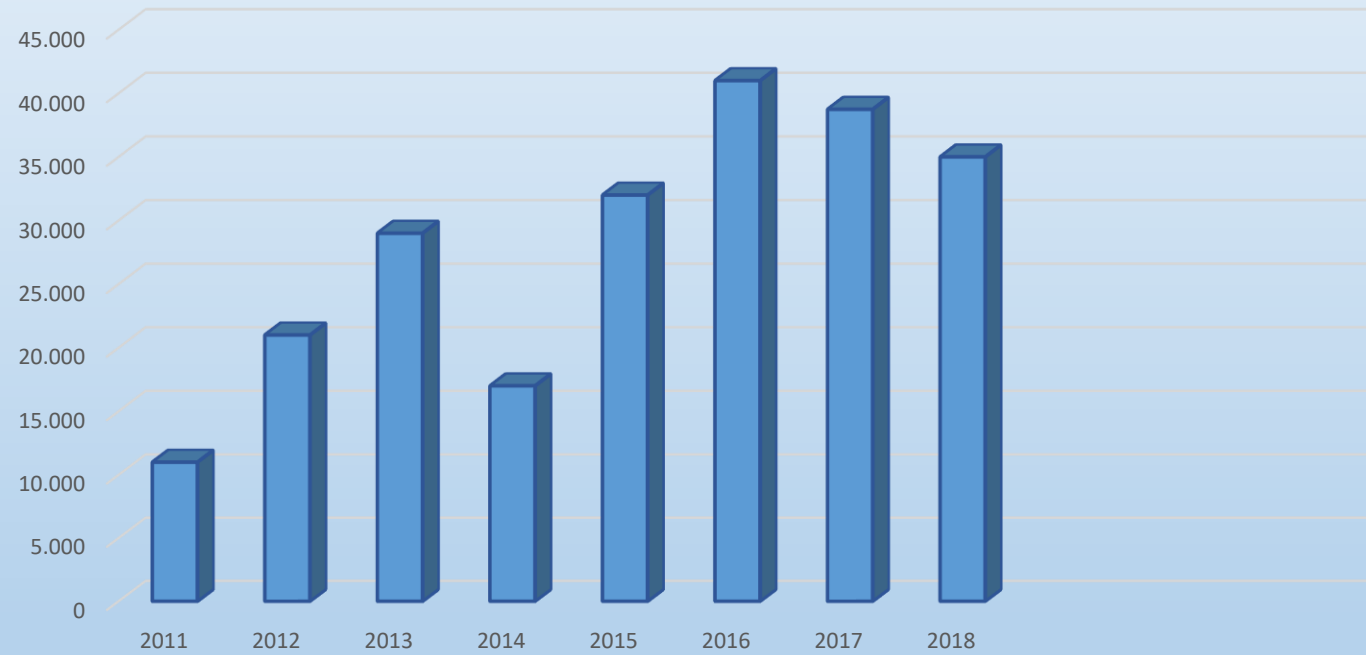
