STUDENTS' PROFILE

- Young people from 16 years old to 20
- Threatened by social exclusion
- Without Secundary Education degree

- Students who have been in the school system, which has failed them
- Young migrants
- Pupils with court order or serving time in a juvenile institution









IDENTITY

- Three main lines of work
 - Educational
 - Vocational training
 - Basic skills
- Joing tutoring: one technical and one classroom teacher per group
- Individualized and flexible approach
- Coordination with other resources
- Combination of affection and boundaries
- Students participate in the decission making process
- Our enrollment process is open yearly









TEACHERS' CHARACTERISTICS

- 21 professionals from different backgrounds including a labour insertion specialist.
- Classroom teachers do not come from the general assignation process
- All teachers coordinate often
- Shared aims and methodology









ITINERARY


Individual for each student, but enmarked in collective work
