Profile of participants:

Adult Education practitioners who are interested in exchanging and developing good practices, methods, materials, tools, pedagogical approaches and/or ways of working in European cooperation. Participants should be committed to plan an Erasmus+ KA1 and/or KA2 Strategic Partnership project on outreach, guidance and motivation. The seminar is open to all programme countries.

Themes and goals of the event:

The aim of the Seminar is to bring together education professionals (Adult Education Field) from participating European countries who wish to explore outreach, guidance and motivation strategies in their practice through Erasmus+ KA1 Mobility and/or KA2 Strategic Partnership projects.

Erasmus+ KA1 Mobility projects support staff of adult education organisations to gain competences in addressing the needs of adult learners with disadvantaged backgrounds through training courses, teaching/training assignments or job shadowing. This contact seminar will help link organisations to facilitate job shadowing or teaching/training assignments in particular.

Erasmus+ KA2 Strategic Partnerships support the development, transfer and implementation of innovative practices as well as the implementation of joint initiatives promoting cooperation, peer learning and exchange of experience at European level. This contact seminar will help link organisations with a view to developing such projects addressing outreach, guidance and motivation strategies.



Expected results:

Participants will create project ideas, develop networks and start the planning process for Erasmus+ KA1 and KA2 projects on outreach, guidance and motivation.

Programme:

The seminar will feature inputs from experts in the area of outreach, guidance and motivation strategies as well as workshops, networking activities and project development. Support around how to make a KA1 Mobility and/or KA2 Strategic Partnership application will feature throughout. The programme will include a cultural event on the evening of Thursday 19 October.

Cost:

Event fee: The event fee will be paid directly to the hosting agency by SEPIE and it will cover accommodation (3 nights) and meals during the activity.

Travel costs: SEPIE will contribute to the travel costs based on the table provided for TCAs. This financial support will be paid directly to the selected participant by SEPIE in compliance with the procedures established by this agency (see information on the SEPIE website).

Support for accommodation and meals not included in the activity programme: SEPIE will contribute to these costs based on the table provided for TCAs. This financial support (up to 2 travel days) will be paid directly to the selected participant by SEPIE in compliance with the procedures established by this agency (see information on the SEPIE website).

Support for participants with special needs: Applicants with special needs might apply for a reimbursement based on real costs. The reimbursement based on real costs will be granted only if it is clearly justified and requested in the application form, and once approved by the national agency (SEPIE). This financial support will be paid directly to the selected participant by SEPIE in compliance with the procedures established by this agency (see information on the SEPIE website). By choosing this option, the participant will renounce to a reimbursement based on unit costs.
