Profile of participants:

The seminar is targeted at all organizations currently active in adult education and training particularly those dealing with the provision of basic skills to at risk/vulnerable groups. Representatives of NGOs or other organizations and NAs involved within the defined topic are welcome to take part in the seminar; newcomers as well as organizations already having some experience in project preparation and implementation are welcome; participants should be willing to exchange good practices and create partnerships for new mobility projects either as sending or receiving partners.

Objectives:

- to give the possibility of **building networks among organizations active in adult education and training particularly those dealing with the provision of basic skills to at risk/vulnerable groups;**
- to encourage Adult Education staff mobility (**staff training** in the form of a work placement or a job shadowing period abroad);
- to give an opportunity to share experiences and discover new approaches in the defined field.

Cost:

Event fee: The event fee will be covered by the hosting national agency: accommodation (4 nights), meals and social/cultural programme.

Support for participants with special needs: Applicants with special needs might apply for a reimbursement based on real costs. The reimbursement based on real costs will be granted only if it is clearly justified and requested in the application form, and once approved by the national agency (SEPIE). This financial support will be paid directly to the selected participant by SEPIE in compliance with the procedures established by this agency (see information on the SEPIE website). By choosing this option, the participant will renounce to a reimbursement based on unit costs.
