







Changes in the upper secondary education in Turku


- Number of the units reduced from 10 to 5 (6) in ten years
 - Concentration of the education and to preserve its quality
 - Larger units offer possibilities for more versatile pedagogics
 - Economical factors
 - Primary and junior high education merged and formed a comprehensive schoolsystem and do co-operation with preschool education
- Upper secondary education has the same schedule in every unit





Changes continues...

- **The same Schedule offers flexibility in organizing teaching**
- **Every unit has its own budget**
 - Principal's responsibility for personnel and resources
- **75 minutes lessons**
- **Change to the digital Matriculation exam autumn 2016**
 - Demands structural changes in the schoolhouses
 - Positive effects to pedagogics -> teachers has to use net
- **Co-operation with the Turku university and with the University of Applied Sciences**




Distribution of the students after the upper secondary school

Competences of Principals

- Background as a teacher
- Always masters level education and special exam
- Appointed by the chief of the education sector
- Key responsibilities
 - Budget, human resources management, pedagogical leader, technical environment ...
- Regular meetings with the principals, members in various work groups

Competences of the teachers

- Masters degree and teacher training school
 - Competence to teach at the upper secondary level
- Application for the post digitally in the recruiting system
- Head of the service area take permanent teachers after interviews
- Great changes in the school environment
 - Digital and mobile teaching (distance learning)
 - New demands for the skills
